- **Option 1: Virtual 30 min (K-grade 3), 45 min (grades 4-6)**

A virtual visit includes a book reading, an age-appropriate creative writing exercise, and Q&A. Promotional bookmarks can be made available for students if booked well enough in advance.

Fee: FREE

- **Option 2: In-Person**

This story time will include a reading of the book, an age appropriate creative writing group activity, Q&A, and promotional materials. The learning can be tailored to your group with themes such as imagination, ingenuity, writing themes (exploring who/what/where/when/how when creating a story), overcoming learning obstacles or becoming an author. Book signing can be arranged (with sales prior to the event).

Fee: \$50/hr (Local); \$100/hr (Travel outside GTA)
